

Aaron Ben-Ze'ev is professor of Philosophy at the University of Haifa. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Chicago (1981). Major books: *The Subtlety of Emotions* (MIT, 2000), *Love Online* (Cambridge UP, 2004), *In The Name of Love* (with Goussinsky, Oxford UP, 2008); *The Arc of Love* (University of Chicago Press, 2019). At the University of Haifa, he was President (2004-2012), Rector (2000-2004), and Dean of Research (1995-2000). He is the Founding and former President of the European Philosophical Society for the Study of Emotions. His research is focused on the study of emotions and in particular, romantic love.
